Dixie Families,


We have been following guidance and information regarding COVID-19 very closely. In light of recent executive orders from the Governor's Office and information about the spread of the virus, we believe that postponing the musical is in the community's best interest.

The Spring Musical is an indoor event where audience members will likely be sitting in close proximity to one another. It is also a family event and we expect many elderly family members to be in attendance. Information from the Ohio Health Department and other agencies has noted that elderly citizens and those with compromised respiratory or immune systems are the most at risk. We do not wish to put family members in the position of having to decide to risk infection in order to attend the show. We also do not want to increase the chances of a family member contracting the virus at the event and taking it home to other family members who may have compromised health conditions.

Those who have purchased tickets for the show this weekend should keep the tickets in a safe place until the weekend of April 24 through 26. The tickets will be honored on the same night/day as they were scheduled for this weekend (i.e. Friday, March 13 tickets will be honored on Friday, April 24). For those who cannot attend the show on the rescheduled date, DHS will refund the price of tickets for those who return them and will exchange tickets for a different time as seating allows.
